For 21 straight years the credit union has awarded scholarships to deserving young members. This year was no exception. The scholarship committee has awarded this year's award to Jennifer Lloyd.

Jennifer is a senior at Matawan Regional High School in Matawan NJ and is ranked 4th amongst 270 students. She has a 4.40 grade point average and scored a 1360 on her SAT exam and a composite score of 31 on her ACT. She has taken 10 Honors courses and 6 AP courses.

Jen is a member of the National Honor Society, the Science Honor Society, the Math Honor Society and Student Council President for all 4 years. In addition she received a Varsity letter in bowling freshman and sophomore year, a member of the Varsity soccer team and the 4 year starting 2nd baseman on the Varsity softball team.


